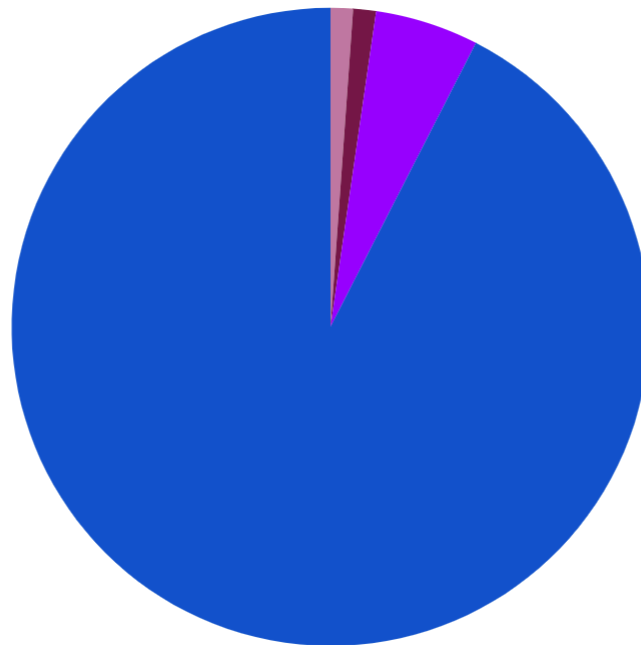

Biggs and Littles NYC: Our one-to-one mentoring program transforms the lives of young people, building hope and inspiring them to dream bigger, work harder to do well in school, and to plan for their future. We reach New York City children age 7 to 19 (providing services through completion of the critical first year of college) and their families, 80% of whom live below the poverty line and 70% are single parent households. 60% of our youth are first generation Americans and will be the first in their families to attend college.
